POLICIES

- All fees and tuition are to be paid in full as of the first day of classes each semester. Other schedules for payment must be approved by the director prior to the beginning of first day of school.
- Room and Board fees are due on a quarterly basis. If a student withdraws early from the boarding program, only the cost of their food for the remaining days of that semester will be refunded to their parents' account.
- 1% per month late fee is chargeable on all accounts in arrears past 30 days.
- All previous semester fees and tuition must have been paid in full before a student can attend the new semester.

- Dalat International School admits students of any race, religion, sex, and national/ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. - Students entering pre-school must be 3 years of age by September 30th. Kindergarten is a prerequisite for Grade 1. A child must be 5 years of age by September 30th for admission to kindergarten.
- Families may apply for financial assistance. Each case will be handled according to need and availability of funds.

MALAYSIAN LAW

- Dalat International School is authorized to educate children holding a non-Malaysian passport.
- The Malaysian Department of Education may grant limited permission for Malaysians to attend Dalat International School.
- All non-Malaysians must have a valid student visa to study at Dalat International School.
