## **POLICIES**

- 1. All fees and tuition are to be paid in full as of the first day of classes each semester. Alternative payment plans must be approved by the Head of School prior to the first day of school.
- 2. Room & Board fees for late entries will be pro-rated on a weekly basis. No refund of Room & Board fees shall be allowed in cases of early withdrawals under any circumstances.
- 3. 10% per month late payment surcharge is chargeable on all accounts in arrears past 30 days.
- 4. All outstanding fees must be fully settled before a student is allowed to attend the new semester.
- 5. All fees/payments are strictly non-refundable unless explicitly stated otherwise. Should a student request a delayed intake or take a sabbatical, they must enrol/re-enroll within one year or the application and registration fee must be paid again.
- 6. Kindly refer to the latest Student-Parent Handbook for more details on the finance policies of the school.
- 7. Refer to Student Handbook for details on charges for late entries and early withdrawals.
- 8. Dalat International School admits students of any race, religion, gender, and national/ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, gender, or national/ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admission policies, athletic, and other school-administered programs.
- 9. Students entering pre-school must be 3 years of age by August 1st. A child must be 5 years of age by August 1st for admission to kindergarten. Kindergarten is a prerequisite for Grade 1.
- The Admissions Committee reserves the right to grant/deny admission. Its decision is final and conclusive.
