### Services and Fees Schedule

#### DLRC Membership

*DLRC Membership Annual Cost: RM1,000 per family*

*One time, returnable damage and loss deposit: RM100*

#### Benefits:

- Dalat Library Access
  - Full access to both elementary and secondary libraries to check out books and materials
  - Online catalog: <http://library.dalat.org> with online access to checkout history (login required)
  - Growing collection of E-Books
  - Online research tools powered by JSTOR, Britannica, and EBSCO Host (login required)
  - Check-out max of 50 resources per family (Dalat and DLRC libraries combined)
  - Two week limit for books, one week for DVDs (DLRC resources have a 90 day limit)
  - Due date extensions available (contact [librarian@dalat.org](mailto:librarian@dalat.org))
  - Main Library Hours: Mon-Fri 7:45am-5pm (also open during most school breaks)
- DLRC Library Access
  - Review textbooks, curriculum, supplementary materials
  - Borrow general TCK and homeschool resources (issues, methods, philosophy, etc.)
  - Borrow supplemental resources and reading materials
  - Borrow games and educational equipment
  - Check-out max of 50 resources per family, 90 day borrow limit (extendable).
- Option of auditing single classes on campus grades 7-12 (eligible for credits on homeschool transcript)
- Option to participate in after school clubs and athletic programs (subject to availability)
- Option to represent Dalat in competitive sports and teams (special requirements apply)
- Informal discussion groups and training sessions offered throughout the year for parents
- Academic Testing services
- Homeschool/TCK consultation services at Dalat
- College/Career counseling services at Dalat
- Assistance with homeschool record keeping and transcripts

Advanced Placement (AP) testing (usually in May)	~USD \$122 + sitting fee of RM150 (300 for unique test) per test
IOWA Testing (U.S. based placement/achievement testing –any time)	USD \$30 per test
Individual Diagnostic Achievement testing (WIAT, WJ III –any time)	USD \$65 per test
